FROM THE CEO

15 years. My, how far we've come!

When a group of women leaders first came together, the goal was simple: develop our current and emerging leaders. Today, Women Lead Change meets all leaders, new, emerging, and executive, where they are in ways that are as diverse as the groups we serve. Conferences and workshops, professional cohorts, public/private initiatives, research, and youth outreach are among the many growth opportunities we've realized in the last five years.

In 2022, Women Lead Change provided leadership development for more than 69 corporate partners and 5,180 attendees. With the anniversary year came our long-awaited return to an in-person conference in Cedar Rapids, Des Moines and the Quad Cities. Our efforts to support girls who will grow into future women leaders led to the inaugural Girls with Goals Become Women of Achievement event. Our Women Connect cohorts expanded into Cedar Falls, joining the Quad Cities, Des Moines Metro, Corridor and Sioux Falls, South Dakota.

In 15 years, our mission hasn't changed, though our work has evolved. We see the growing need for support in educating our partners on ways to adapt to the changing workforce. Hybrid work environments require new intention on the way we develop leaders and foster a team culture. In 2022, we launched our first industry-specific leadership development programming, Level Up Manufacturing. This program is now offered in the Corridor and the Quad Cities and is for women and men. We also announced the One Team Summit. This is a half-day event in Coraville, designed to bring teams together while providing tactical strategies for team building within organizations.

The saying is true: the more things change, the more they stay the same. The Iowa Women's Leadership Conference was born out of the need for workforce, specifically including underutilized women in the conversation. Today, post-Covid, we find ourselves in eerily the same situation. Women have fallen back or disappeared from the workforce in unprecedented numbers. We need them back. In the lead. Leading Change!


